

THERE'S A NEW WORD TO DESCRIBE THE GOVERNMENT OF ONTARIO'S ENERGY PLAN.

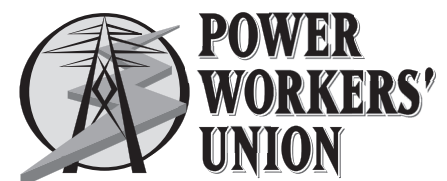
BLACKOUTS.

This summer Ontario needed much more energy than it could generate. Our strained power system forced 23 emergency power alerts, 12 days of urgent public appeals and the implementation of a 5% voltage reduction for two days in August. We were faced with the very real possibility of rotating blackouts.

To protect against these outages, we were forced to import our electricity from the United States at up to 15 times more than what we normally pay. And make no mistake. Our electricity situation will only get worse if the government insists on going ahead with its proposed energy plan.

Fortunately there is a better plan. A Better Plan that was developed in consultation with energy experts, business leaders, economists and the general public. It is a plan that helps Ontario meet its energy needs today and well into the future at an affordable cost.
