

HOMEOWNERS HAVE A NEW WORD FOR ONTARIO'S HIGH ELECTRICITY COSTS.

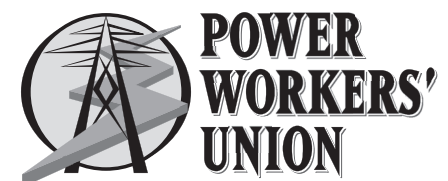
SHOCKING.
